As part of our history topic, which focuses on World War 2, we are organising two World War days for all the children in Year 4. The days will enable the children to experience various activities focused on what life was like in 1940's Britain for children. These history days will be held on Thursday 30th November and Friday 1st December and will take place in normal school hours.

We are asking the children to dress up as evacuees on both days. To help you with this task we have provided a list below which you can use as a point of reference.



Please can the children all come in on Thursday 30th with a small box. This will be wrapped in brown paper at school to make it look like a gas mask box which they will have to carry with them throughout the day. Also on Thursday 30th November a theatre group is coming in to perform a play called 'Thompson's War' which will give valuable insight into life as an evacuee during World War 2.

Dressing Guide

Everyone should wear -
Shoes, boots or wellies (no trainers!!)
Woollen jumper or cardigan (no sweatshirts)



Boys - shirt and long shorts or trousers cut off below the knee

Girls - blouse and skirt or dress
