

<u>Maths Overview – Year 5; Autumn 2; Week 6</u>

Main objective: Solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems in familiar contexts, deciding which operations and methods to use and why

Activities: This week pupils will be learning to solve a variety of word problems. There are differentiated PPTs available – you can select one to focus on and work through each day.

Your children might find it beneficial to use bar modelling as a way of visualising how to solve these problems. There are some templates available that you could use before working out the answer.

<u>Individual Work:</u> Remind the children of NO PROBS to help solve their problems. There is a large range of word problems that involve addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Some of these are single step and might be more suited for the lower ability.

Some of these are multi-step and could be better for middle ability.

Some require using a mixture of operations to find the answers. These would be more suited to the higher ability.
