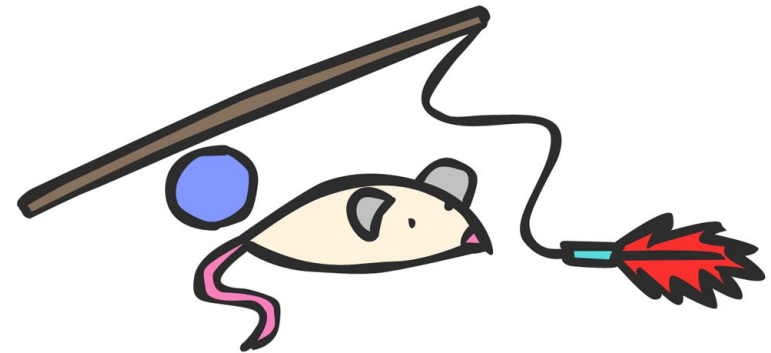

(The umbrella of the boy)



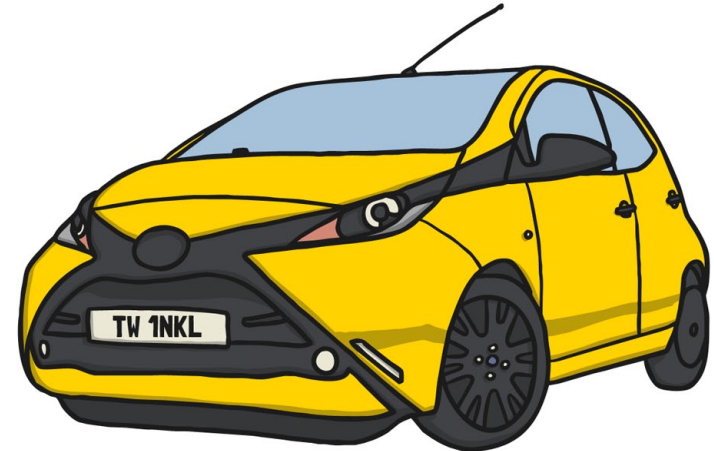
The cat's toys

The man's car

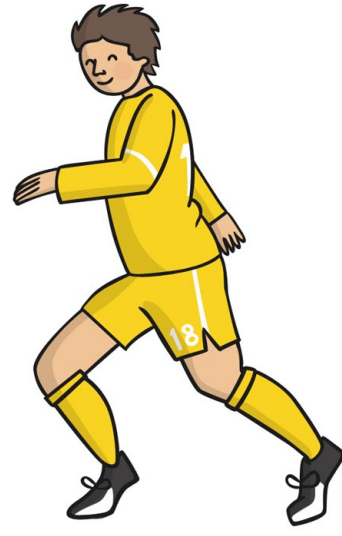
Add 's to the word, even if it ends in **s**.

The puppies' bed

Add ' to the word.

Apostrophes

for missing out letters in words

should've
(should have)

she's
(she is)

can't
(can not)

they'll
(they will)

it's
(it is)

we're
(we are)

Apostrophes

for making plurals of lowercase letters

There are 2 t's in bitter.

Mind your p's and q's.

This rule only applies to lowercase letters, not capitals, numbers or symbols.
