Converting Improper Fractions to Mixed Fractions

To convert an improper fraction to a mixed fraction, follow these steps:



- Divide the numerator by the denominator.
- Write down the whole number answer
- Then write down any remainder above the denominator.

Example: Convert $\frac{11}{4}$ to a mixed fraction.

Divide:

$$\rightarrow$$
 11 ÷ 4 = 2 with a remainder of 3

Write down the 2 and then write down the remainder (3) above the denominator (4).

Answer:

$$2\frac{3}{4}$$
