## You will need:

- scissors
- glue
- pink, yellow and blue colouring pencils
- double-sided tape.

## What to do:

- Colour the patch on top of the head blue.
   Colour the inside of the mouth pink.
   Colour the thin stripe on the neck yellow.
   Leave the rest of the snapper white.
- Cut all around the outside of the blue tit snapper.
- Fold the snapper along the dotted lines with the coloured area facing outwards.
   Make sure you fold across the middle of the mouth too.
- Apply glue as marked.
   Match A and B glued sections under the head and beak, squeezing to stick in place.
- Inside the top and bottom halves of the beak where circles are marked, stick a little piece of doublesided tape. Put your fingers on the tape and start snapping!
