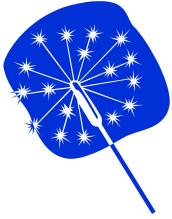
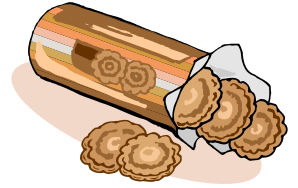


## Multiplication Word Problem Detectives (L)

1. Gemma thinks that each person at her party will eat three biscuits each. There will be six people. How many biscuits will she need?

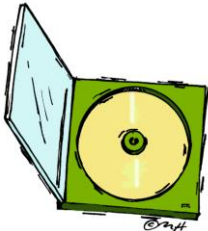


2. There are 6 sparklers in a box. Joseph has 4 boxes. How many sparklers does he have altogether?

4. Albert wants to buy 4 lollies for each of his seven friends. How many lollies will he need to buy?



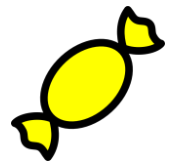
5. Libby has 3 boxes of CD's. Each box holds 10 CDs. How many CDs does she have altogether?
