Take a cutting of a plant – can you make it grow again? <i>Resources: Taking Cuttings sheet Flower picture Parts of a flower information cards</i>	<u>Mammal Life Cycle</u> Can you explain the key features of a mammal’s life cycle? Use appropriate vocabulary and definitions. <i>Resources: Various mammal life cycles</i>	<u>Jane Goodall</u> Produce an information leaflet persuading people to fundraise and donate to the endangered chimpanzee charity. Explore the work of Jane Goodall with monkeys. <i>Resources – Activity sheet advert Activity sheet Jane Goodall</i>	<u>Metamorphosis</u> To explain the process of metamorphosis, giving examples of various animals. Use key vocabulary. Resources – Amphibians and insects activity sheet
Humanities – 1950’s onwards	<u>Music</u> Produce a persuasive poster for a music festival, referencing influential bands / acts from the past. <i>Resources – Festival poster</i>	<u>Fashion</u> To design an outfit related to the 1950s, 60s or 70s using inspiration from research. <i>Resources – Design a 50s, 60s or 70s outfit.</i>	<u>Toys</u> Research and compare two toys from modern day and the past. What has changed about them? How have they been enhanced by modern technology? Why are they still so successful? <i>Resources – Toy comparison table</i>	<u>Food</u> Write a food review about a food item from the 1950’s onwards i.e. Spam, Smash. Can you use descriptive language to make it sound more appetising? What ingredients were used and why was it so popular? <i>Resources – Food review</i>

Draw a variety, testing size and ease of reproducing. <i>Resources – Match tracks</i>	<u>Animal Prints</u> Choose a favourite animal footprint and draw in a 10x10 square. This will then be printed in a rotation to imitate the style of William Morris. <i>Resources – Examples</i>	<u>Animal Prints</u> Print your chosen animal footprint in a rotation.
