-  Use your notes and knowledge to create an information page about orang-utans. If you prefer, you can make a poster, leaflet or fact file. Illustrate your work with drawings or pictures.
-  Think about your rainforest work completed in school. Is this piece completed to the same standard? Can you develop your sentences further or add more exciting vocabulary?
