

<p><b>Literacy and Communication</b></p>	<p>Research an environmental issue e.g. pollution, water wastage, fossil fuels, landfill, and write a report about it. Include the features of reports that you learned last half term (The rainforest).</p> <p>10 points</p>	<p>Write a play script. Make sure you set it out in the correct way and include the features of play scripts including stage directions and brackets.</p> <p>10 points</p>	<p>Find a poem that you like, write it out in your best handwriting, illustrate it and learn at least two verses off by heart and perform it to someone.</p> <p>2 weeks - 20 points</p>
<p><b>Science and the wider world</b></p>	<p>In science we have been learning about animals. Make a fact page about your favourite animal which you encountered at Drusillas vertebrate or invertebrate.</p> <p>10 points</p>	<p>Research electrical circuits and produce something to show what you have learned. This can be an actual circuit you have built, a poster, a fact file, a PowerPoint...it's up to you!</p> <p>10 points</p>	<p>Help to make a healthy meal (breakfast/lunch or dinner) at home. Include the recipe, photos and evaluation. Who did you serve it to? What did they think? What made it a healthy choice?</p> <p>10 points</p>
<p><b>Humanities</b></p>	<p>Create a PowerPoint about Victorian inventors or inventions.</p> <p>10 points</p>	<p>Find out about Worthing in Victorian times. Can you find out where the prison was situated? Are there any Victorian buildings still in the town? What was the town like in Victorian times? When was the pier built and what did it look like? You can present your research in any way you wish.</p> <p>10 points or 20 for an in-depth project</p>	<p>Find a Victorian recipe, write it out (or word process it) and then make the recipe. Take photos of your work and feel free to bring in the finished product!</p> <p>10 Points</p>
<p><b>Citizenship</b></p>	<p>Choose a song that you really love and rewrite the words to make it about a citizenship topic of your choice e.g. recycling, respect, friendship, community.</p> <p>10 points</p>	<p>Write about a family member <b>in French</b> (or make a character up) using the vocabulary that you have learned in school e.g. my name is..., I am 10 years old, I live in....Draw a picture of them and write the information in full sentences.</p> <p>10 points</p>	<p>Find out about a religious festival of your choice and present your work in any way you wish.</p> <p>10 points</p>
<p><b>Creative Arts</b></p>	<p>If you visited a seaside resort like Worthing in Victorian times you would probably have seen a Punch and Judy show. We'd like you to find out about this entertainment and tell us about it. Can you make something that would have been used in a show? Or you could draw the characters and explain their roles.</p> <p>2 weeks - 20 points</p>	<p>Sewing challenge! Design and sew a Christmas or room decoration. We'd like a step by step guide in your book of how you made it.</p> <p>2 weeks - 20 points</p>	<p>Paint or sketch a portrait of Queen Victoria, or another famous Victorian. Draw a decorative frame around your picture. We would expect you to draft the picture first before producing a best copy.
