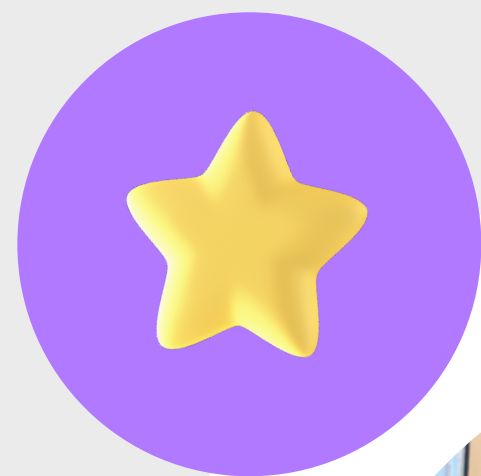




Lunch and Snacks

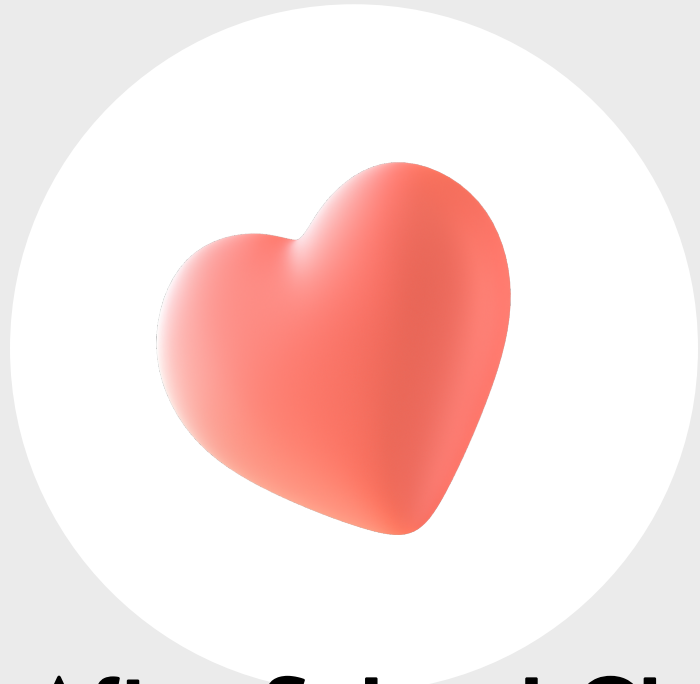
We have someone with severe allergies in our year group.

We expect our children to do their best in their lessons, but we also value having fun and giving the children the best opportunity to love learning and coming to school.



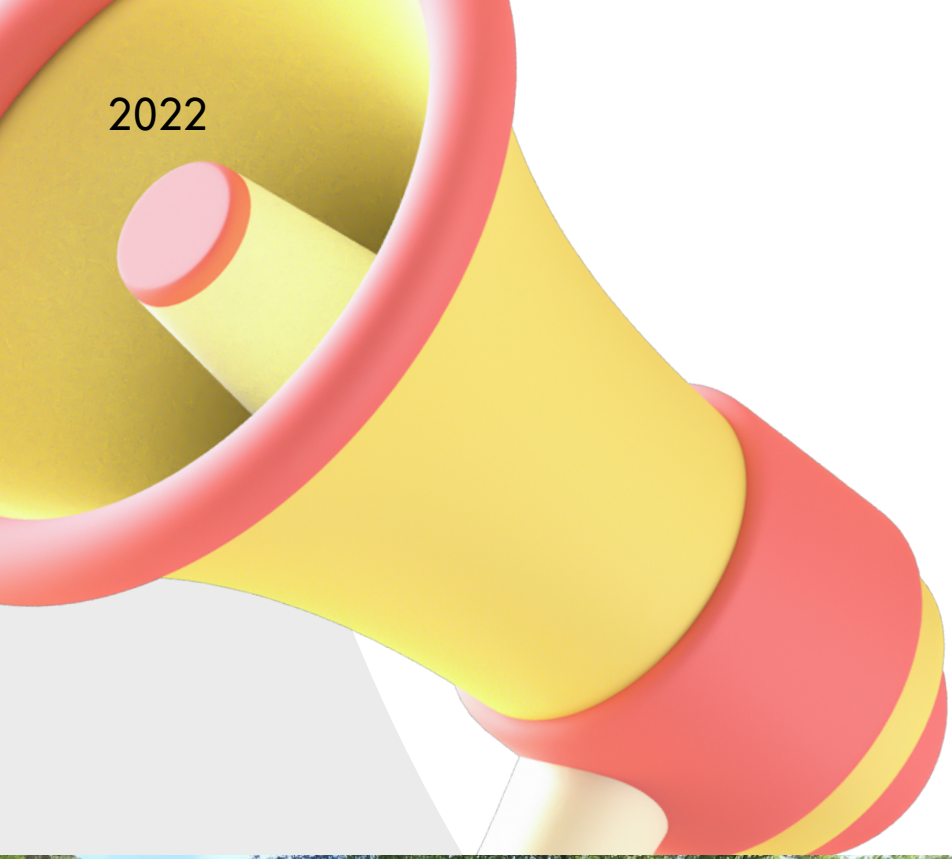

Across the year, you will get to do lots of fun activity days - some charity sponsored events too!

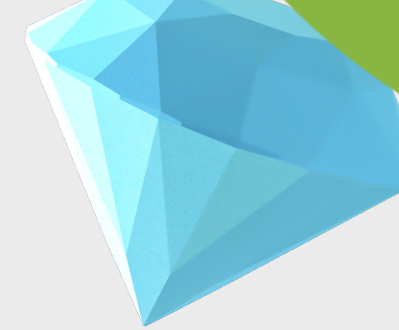


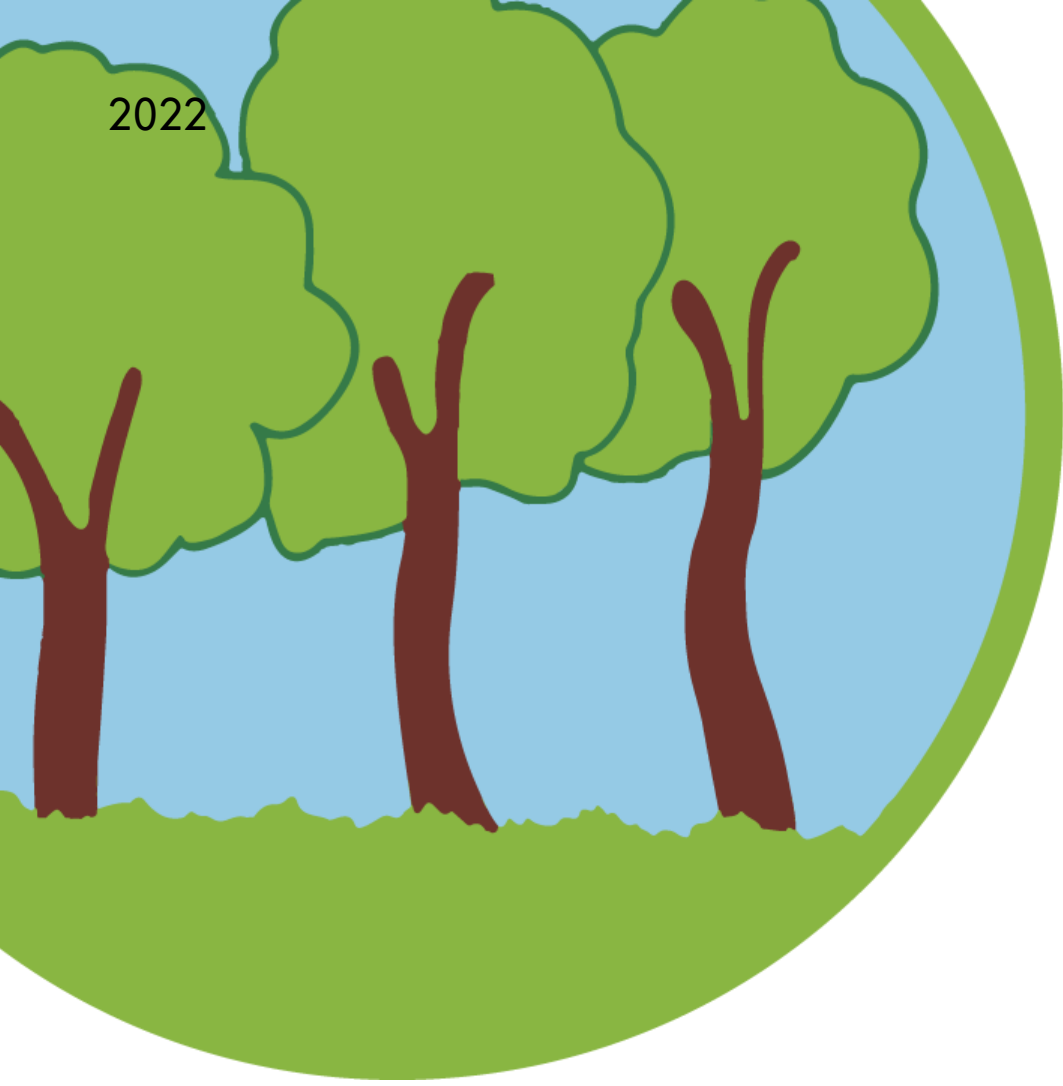

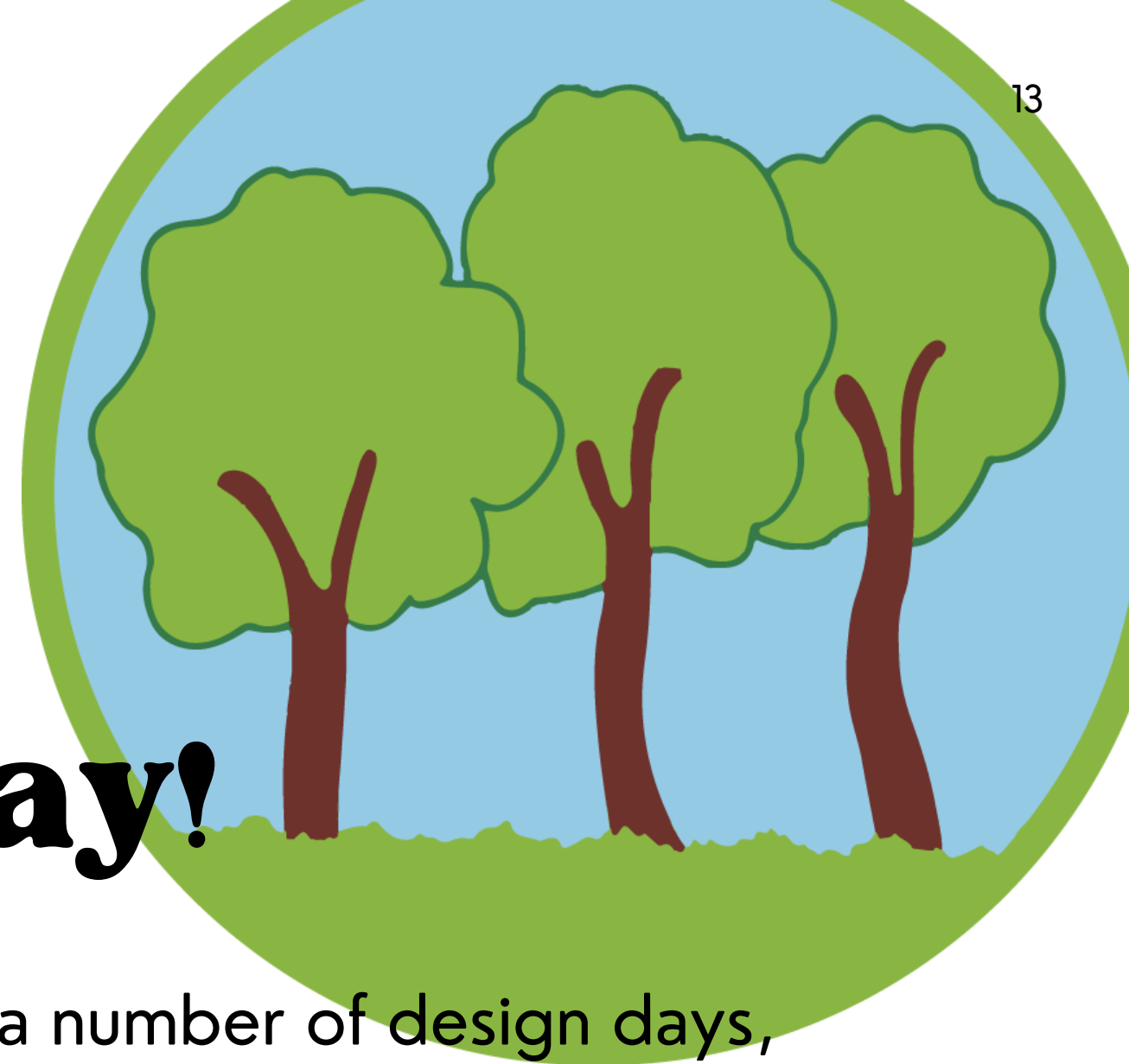
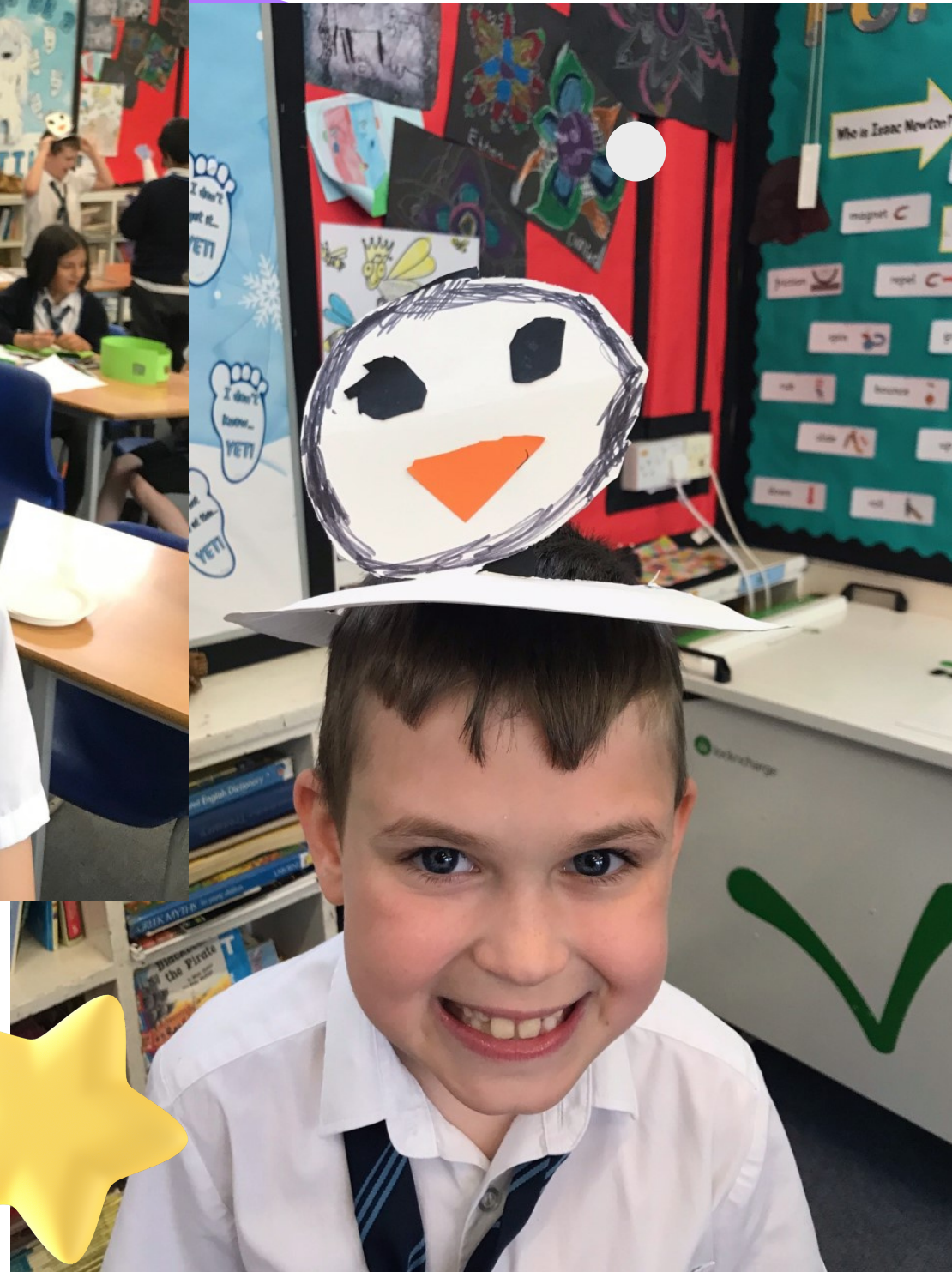




Clubs

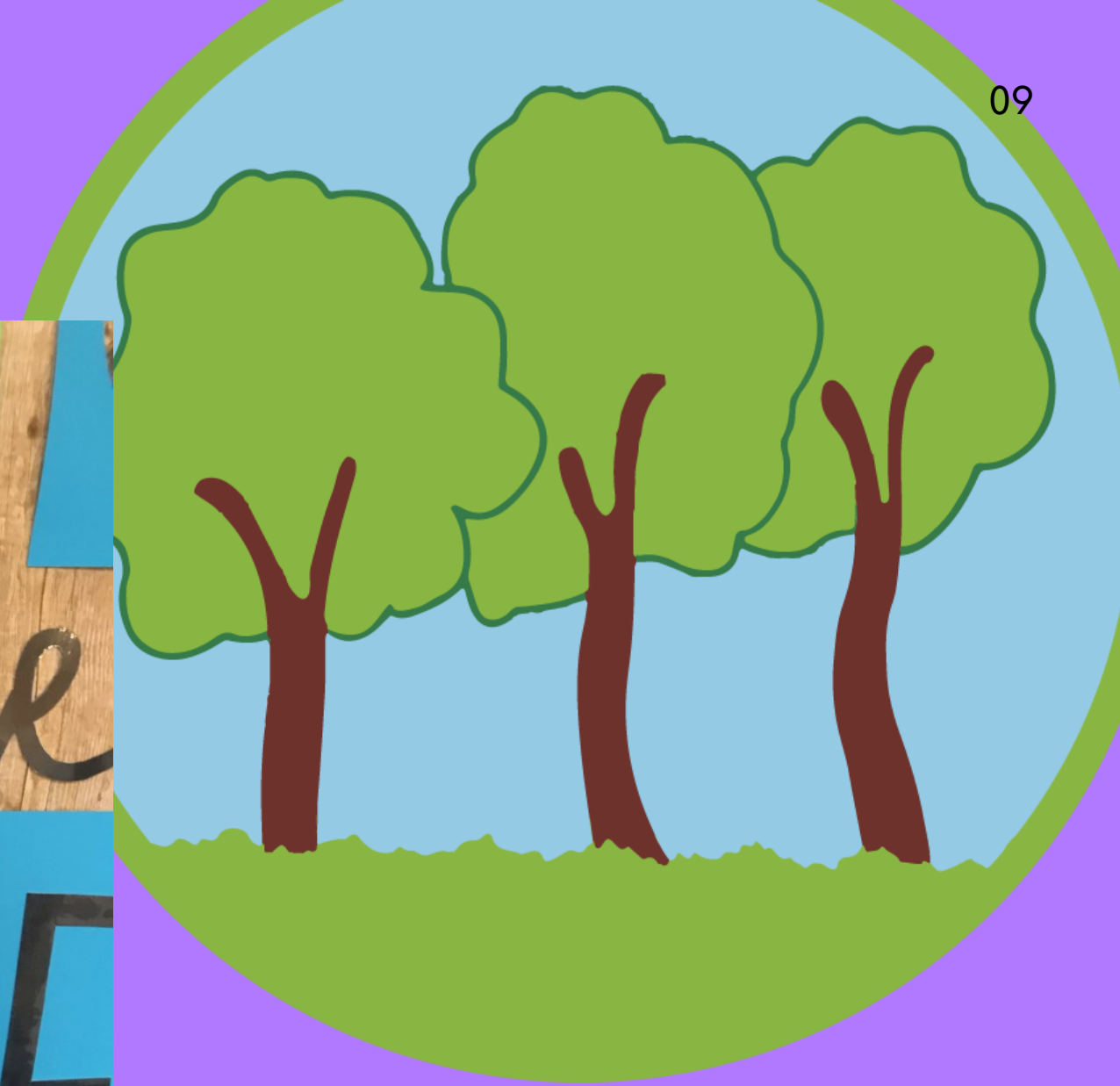
