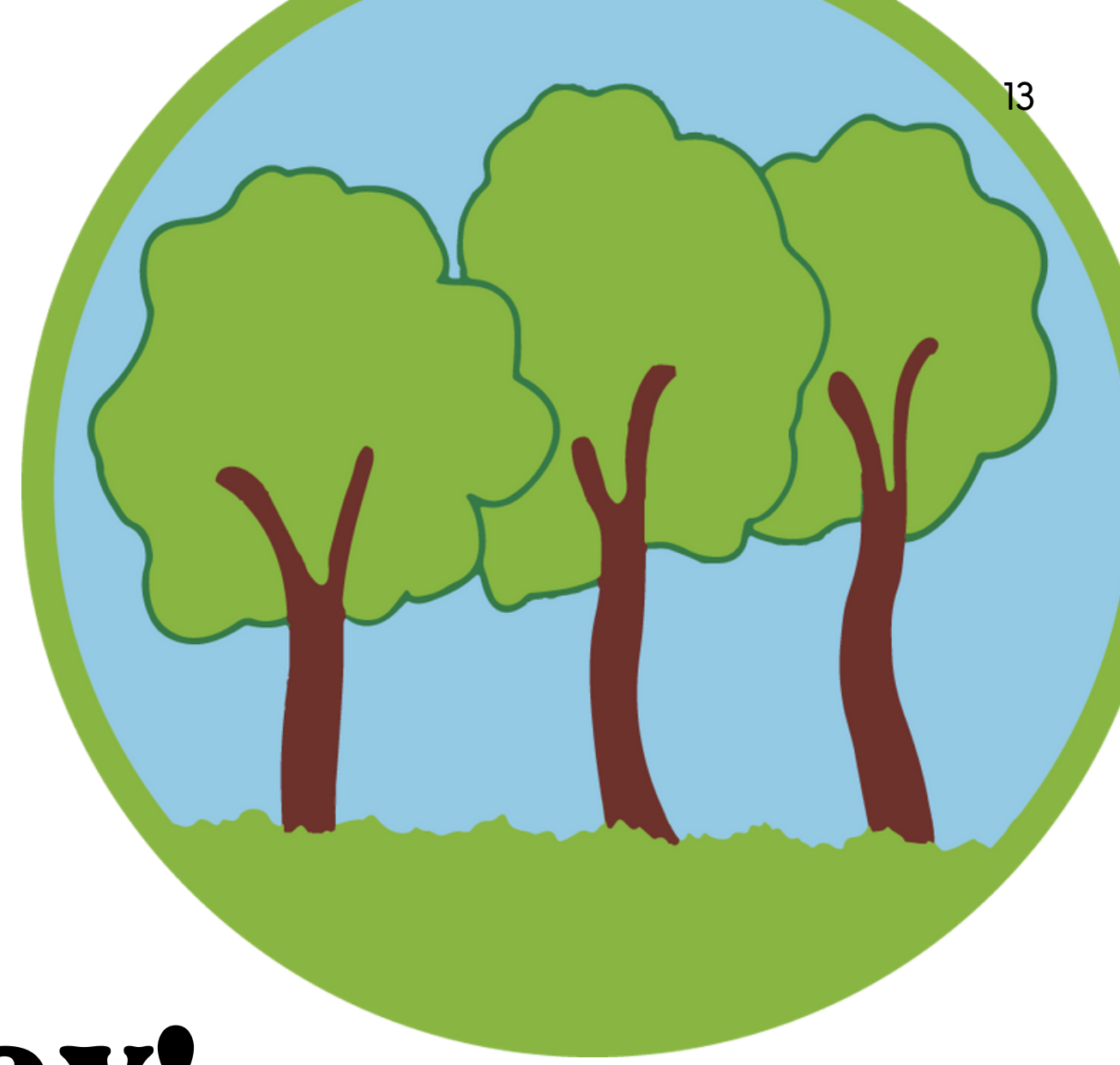




Clubs
