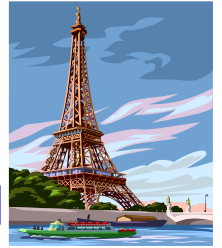

Year 6 Trip to Paris and Disneyland 20th – 22nd May 2024

Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for asking for information relating to our year 6 residential trip. We are now in a position to invite you to pay a deposit if you wish your child to attend.

As discussed at the meeting, the trip will take place over three days, leaving school in the early morning of Monday 20th May and returning on Wednesday 22nd May @ approx. 10p.m. The basic itinerary will be as follows:

- Day 1 – Pick up by coach from school in the morning. Travel to Dover and then by ferry across to Calais. We will have lunch on the ferry (children need to bring a packed lunch). Drive to the Nausicaa Sea Life Centre in Boulogne where we will spend a few hours exploring the exhibitions. We will then have our evening meal at McDonald's en-route to Paris. Arrive at the Campus Saint Therese Hotel just outside Paris at 21:30h.
- Day 2 – Full day at Disneyland Park, where lunch will be provided, followed by our evening meal at The Royal Pub restaurant. We will return to the park after dinner for more rides, shopping and spectacular firework display.
- Day 3 – Drive by coach into the centre of Paris for a short tour of the major sights ending at the Eiffel Tower. From here we will enjoy a one-hour cruise on the River Seine including a picnic lunch. We will eat dinner on the ferry home and aim to arrive back to school around 22:00h.

Every child at The Orchards is given opportunities to enhance their day to day learning, and many of these take place with no cost to yourselves. This trip is an exciting residential opportunity for your child, which we think offers them a unique experience. There is a financial cost involved and the school could not afford to offer this without agreement from you to meet this cost. We are happy to have a discussion with you to negotiate an instalment plan that suits you, rather than our proposed one. If you wish to speak to Dr Jones in confidence about different payment arrangements, please do not hesitate to contact him to arrange an appointment. Please be aware that your child will require a passport, which parents will be required to fund.

However, any agreed payment schedule must be adhered to in order to secure your child's place on this trip and the full deposit must be paid for a place to be allocated.

The total cost of the trip, which is slightly increased from previous years, is £400 and the payment schedule will be:

£100 deposit no later than FRIDAY 6th October 2023- **THIS WILL BE NON-REFUNDABLE**

£100 due by Friday 24th November 2023

£100 due by Friday 26th January 2024

£100 due by Friday 23rd February 2024

We cannot hold places without a deposit, and once places are filled, names will be put on a waiting list. All deposits should be paid through the Arbor system that we operate at Orchards; this will record all further payments and also be your permission for the trip.

If you would like your child to be included on this trip, please log-on to Arbor to make your deposit payment of £100 which is non-refundable.

We will be holding a further meeting in the spring of 2024 giving you final details about the trip.



So you have lots of time to get these items, we are letting you know that:

⌚ Each child will need to have their own valid Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC) – these replace the EHIC. They should be free of charge and are available at <https://www.gov.uk/global-health-insurance-card> This card must be in school by Friday 19th April 2024.

⌚ Each child will also need their own passport. Please do not leave this until the last minute, child passports can take some time to process. Passport applications can be completed online or forms can be collected from Post Offices. The charge for a first-time application of a child passport is currently £53.50 online, or £64 for a paper application. Some post offices also offer a 'Check and send' service. Please check the date of an existing passport as we understand it must have 6 months left from the time of travel to the expiry date. A valid passport must be in school by Friday 19th April 2024.

⌚ If you bring these items in earlier, that would be greatly appreciated.
