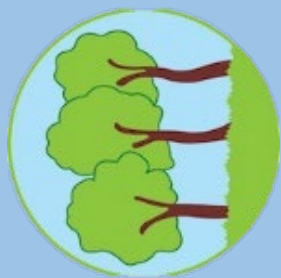


What you need to know...



Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are all very excited to present the opportunity of a residential trip to Little Canada Wednesday 1st May – Friday 3rd May 2024. We have booked a provisional 90 places. This brochure should outline key information needed...

Little Canada

Situated on the Isle of Wight. Set in a beautiful 48-acre woodland site. We get to travel by boat!!!

Some of the activities available may include... abseiling, aero ball, archery, buggy building, climbing, giant swing, low ropes, orienteering, tunnel trail and zip wire!

Accommodation

We'll be sleeping in these lovely log cabins.

Each cabin has its own en suite toilet/shower.

Rooms will be allocated in groups of 4 and 6.

Site is secure with no off-site access and staff operating a night patrol.



Travel

We'll be travelling on the ferry which is a short journey to the island. Children will be split into small travel groups and have a designated group leader to ensure a smooth journey. They don't need to worry about lugging bags around whilst on the ferry as these will be left on the coach.

Medical Procedures

We'll be following the latest government guidance and procedures put in place by PGL for our trip.

We will discuss all medical requirements prior to the trip and contact PGL of any additional needs your child may have.

All PGL instructors are qualified in first aid.

Hot & cold options are available at every mealtime. Meals are balanced to keep energy high! PGL cater for many dietary requirements.

Payment

The total cost of the trip is £300, which includes transport there and back, ferry to and from the island, accommodation, meals and all of the activities whilst at the centre. We have set out an affordable payment plan as follows:
