GARGOYLES



We will study gargoyles and understand their religious and historical significance. Using charcoal and chalk, we will create an explosive composition. We will then create either a wall-hanging or a statue of a gargoyle using clay.



BATIK

'Batik' is a technique used for dyeing clothes and creating interesting designs. It is a type of 'wax-resist dyeing' and is used in countries all over the world. We will learn to draw and design a rainforest themed batik and follow the batik process effectively using wax and fabric dyes.

ART APPRECIATION

Children will be given the opportunity to research key artists from across history, work in the style of a chosen artist and produce an independent piece.
