Take Your Time
Simplify what you are saying
Have patience and relax
Show facial emotion

Don't face away
Don't approach from behind
Don't cover your face or mouth
Don't shout
Don't move your head whilst
speaking
Don't rush or panic
Don't over exaggerate
Don't try to finger spell whole
sentences
Have a sense of humour
