WRITING WITH ADVERBS

- A word that describes a verb is an **ADVERB**.
Some adverbs answer the question “how?”
- The dog barked **LOUDLY**.
- The tiger waits **PATIENTLY**.
- The girl sits **QUIETLY**.

ADVERBS THAT TELL WHERE AND WHEN.

- Some adverbs answer the question “Where?”
- It has beautiful pictures **INSIDE**.

- Some adverbs answer the question “When?”
- Let’s travel to the beach **TODAY**.

PREPOSITION OR ADVERB?!

Adverbs describe the verb.

He ran outside.

Prepositions describe the noun.

He was outside the classroom.
