

MNEMONICS FOR SPELLINGS

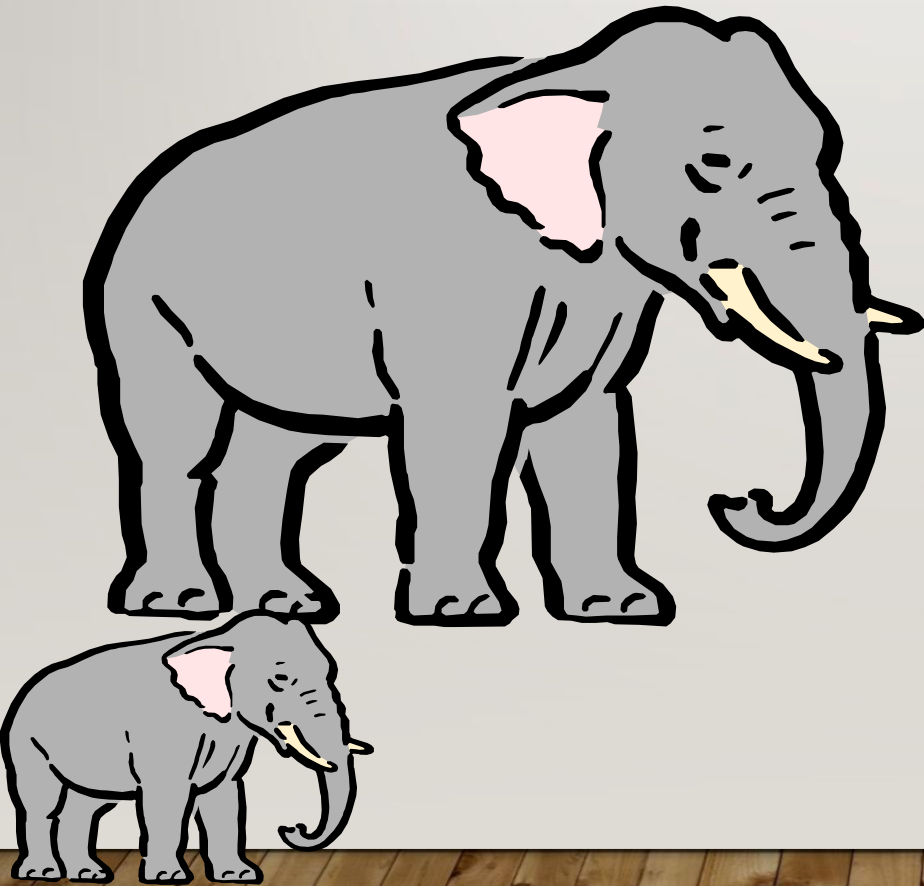
A mnemonic is a silly sentence or rhyme that sticks in your mind and helps you remember something difficult.

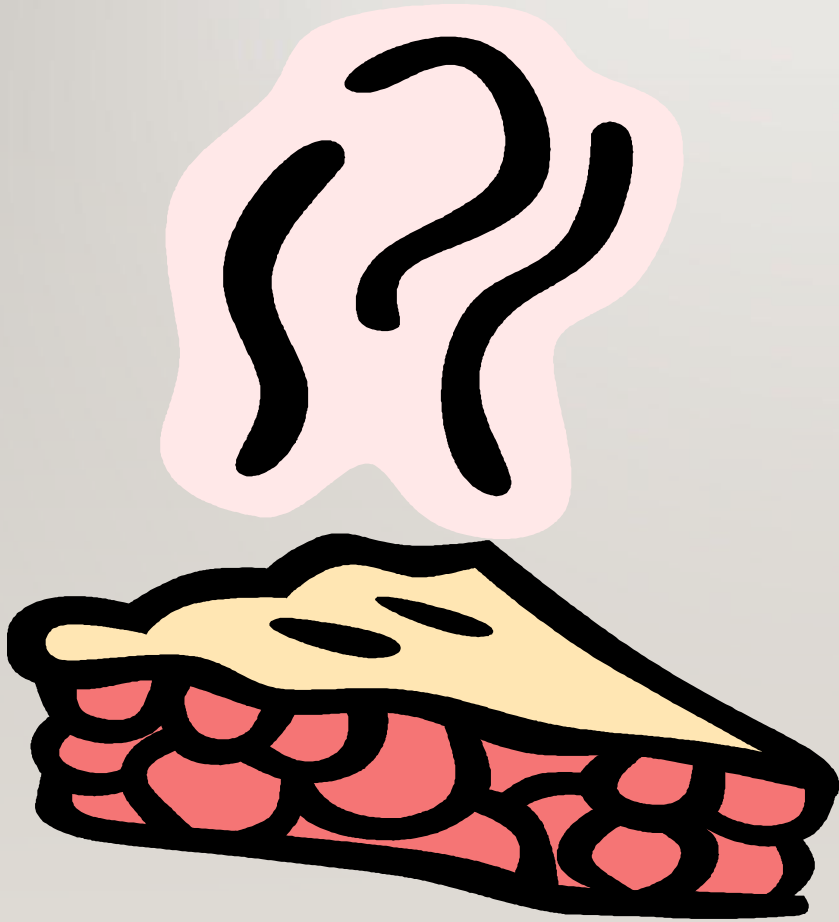

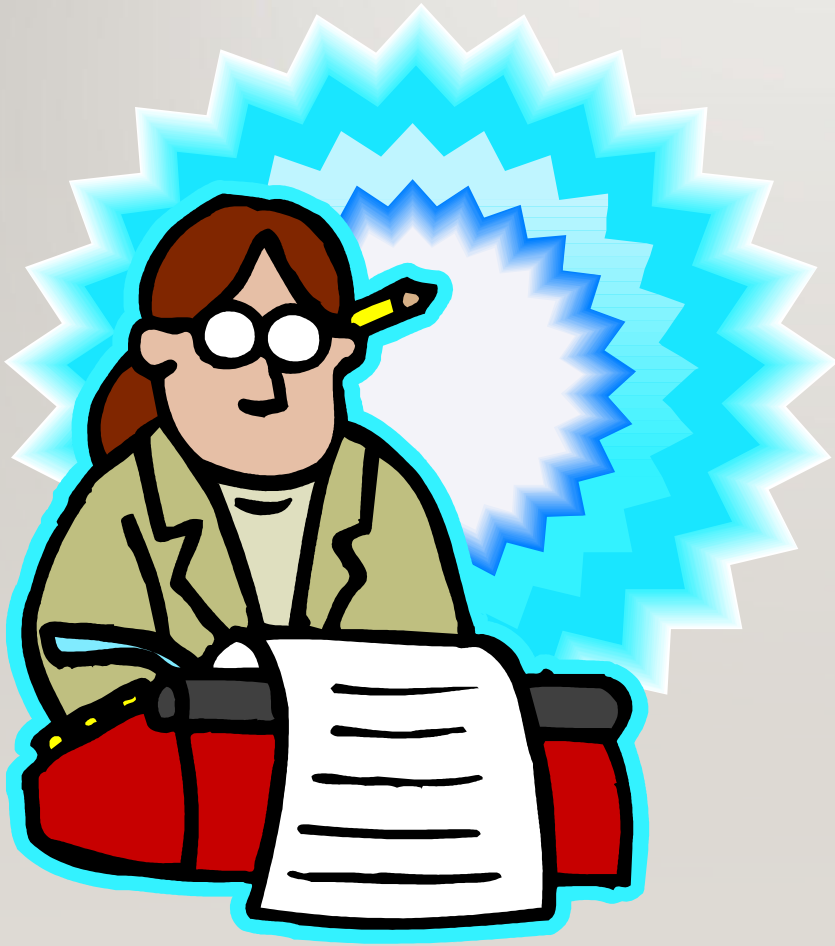

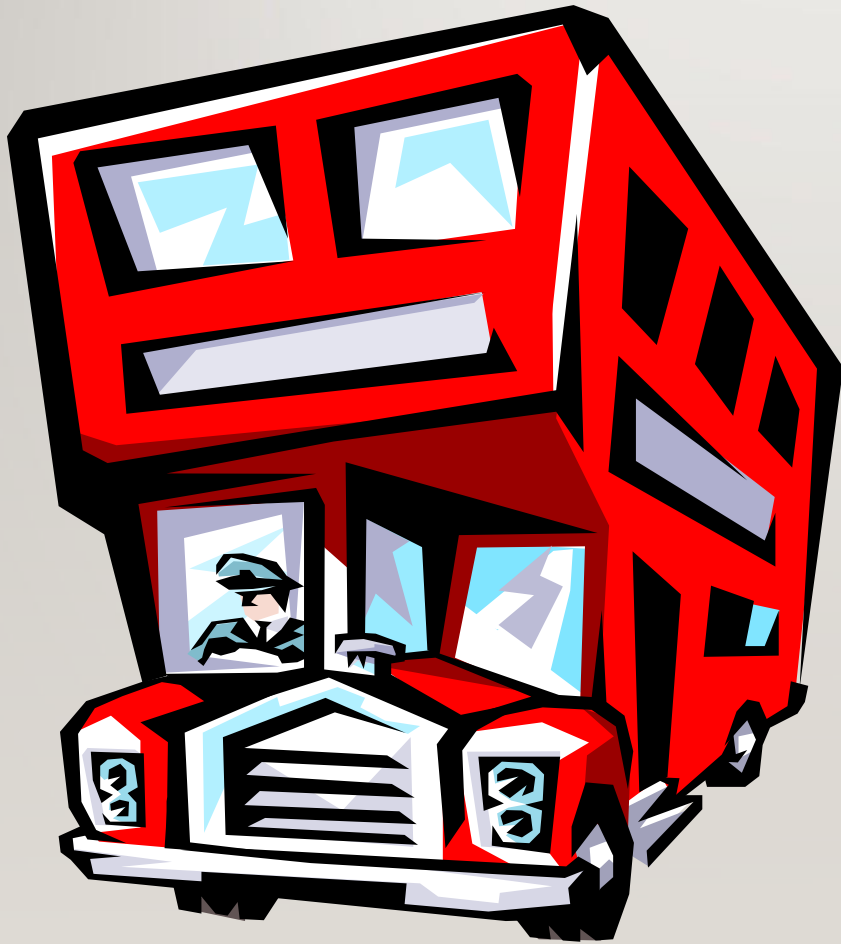
