USEFUL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

SCHOOL DAY AND PUNCTUALITY

When arriving and leaving each day, pupils must go through the school gates at the entrance to the playground.

If your child has been for an appointment, you must report to the front office to give your child's name before they go through to their class.

08:30 – School gates open – children go straight to their class.

08:45 – School day starts – Registers are taken. If your child is late to school after the gates are locked, they must report to the front office giving their name and class and for the time to be recorded.

14:45 – End of school day – Please wait outside the school gates as your child will exit through the playground gates.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

If your child is unwell, please either ring and leave a message on our telephone system or send an email to enquiries@orchardsjunior.school before 08:45 to let us know **each morning** the reason why your child will not be attending.

If your child is marked as not being in class for registration, we will send a text message to request a reason; therefore punctuality is very important.
If we do not receive an explanation for any absences, they will be coded as unauthorised.

Medical appointments – Please let us know, in advance, appointment dates and times in writing.

TERM TIME ABSENCE

Parents are not permitted to take their child out of school during term time for leave.

Any necessary leave must be applied for by using a 'Request for Absence due to Exceptional Circumstances' form that you can get from the front office or our website. If you wish the request to be considered by the Headteacher, you must explain the reason for exceptional circumstances. You will be contacted when this has been considered.

SCHOOL GROUNDS / ORCHARDS STAFF CAR PARK

For the safety of our pupils, it is **NOT PERMITTED FOR PARENTS TO DRIVE INTO THE SCHOOL CAR PARK AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY** to drop off or to wait to pick up your child.

MOBILE TELEPHONES

Some pupils have mobile phones. The school cannot take responsibility for these if they are left in a pupil's possession. Mobile phones should only be brought to school **IF ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY**, be switched off and handed into the Class Teacher at the beginning of the day and collected at the end of the day.

No other equipment or personal items (e.g. ipads etc.) should be brought to school.

CYCLES/SCOOTERS

If your child decides to bring their cycle or scooter to school, there are racks in the playground. We would emphasise that the school **CANNOT ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY** for the loss or damage to cycles or scooters whilst on the premises. Cycles/scooters should not be left outside the school building or against the school railings.

USEFUL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS



Arbor is an integral part of our School Management Information System and carries all of our pupil data, allowing parents to view their child's profile online and sign up and pay for clubs and trips, as well as purchase items such as uniform from the school shop. It is also used to communicate important and general information when necessary. When your child starts Orchards, we will send out details of how to join the **Arbor Parent Portal** by downloading the **Arbor Parent and Guardian Portal App**.

BREAKFAST CLUB

We offer a Breakfast Club that will run every weekday morning between 7:30am – 8:30am (latest arrival by 8:15am) except for Bank Holidays, School Holidays and Inset Days. The cost will be £4.00 per day, per child, bookable and payable through the **Arbor Parent Portal**.

PERSONAL INFORMATION / COMMUNICATION

If you change your address or any telephone numbers (for yourself or contacts for your child), please make sure that we are kept up to date in case of emergencies. Please forward in writing any changes to the school office or send a request via the **Arbor Parent Portal**.

We also have **Class Dojo** which is a direct link between teacher and parents/carers. The Class Teacher will send out an invite to parents/carers via email to access this application when your child starts Orchards.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Orchards offers a wide range of after school clubs, during term time, for each year group. Clubs that your child is eligible to join will be announced at the beginning of the Autumn and Summer terms. Applying for after school clubs is managed through our **Arbor Parent Portal**. Instructions on how to sign your child up to these clubs will be communicated to you via this app.

4 O'CLOCK CLUB

We also offer a paid for after school club each term day where the children take part in various fun activities and are provided with a snack. The sessions run from 2:45—4:00pm at a cost of £5.00 per session, per child. Bookings can be made and paid for through the **Arbor Parent Portal**.

SCHOOL TRIPS

During your child's time here at Orchards they will have many opportunities to take part in a variety of trips and off site activities. All of these will be announced by email from the school and consent for participation and payment (if required) can be completed on the **Arbor Parent Portal**.

WATER POLICY

As a school we would wish our pupils to be in the best physical state for learning and so we would like to make sure that all pupils have access to water throughout the day. Every child will be provided with a free sports-top water bottle when they start our school. These should be washed daily and filled with fresh water. **For hygiene reasons, please remember to have your child's name clearly shown.** If this bottle should be lost, you can buy a replacement from the school shop on Arbor at a cost of £3.00.

BREAKTIME SNACK

All children are allowed to bring a healthy snack to school, which they can have during their breaktime. We have some children who have severe nut allergies so would remind you that you are not allowed to bring nuts or nut related items in to school for snacks or lunches.

USEFUL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

LOST PROPERTY

PLEASE ENSURE ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING ARE NAMED.

If items of clothing are mislaid and they are named, they will be returned to the owner.

Children can check with Mrs Carter for any lost property as all misplaced items are returned to her office.

Any lost property which is unnamed and is not claimed by the end of each term will be put in our 'Pre-loved Uniform Shop', more details of which can be found below.

STIKINS LABELS

We have teamed up with Stikins to offer parents the opportunity to purchase quality labels for your child's uniform, whilst earning the school commission at the same time; this commission can then be used to help fund resources that benefit our children's learning. The labels are really easy to use, they just stick onto your child's clothing, shoes, lunchboxes etc. – no sewing or ironing! The labels are also washing machine and tumble dryer safe. All information is on our school website under Parent Tab—Uniform—and if you use the link to order your labels online, the school reference number (14954) is filled in automatically for you.

PRE-LOVED UNIFORM SHOP

Our Pre-loved Uniform Shop has an excellent range of school uniform and sundry items. All pre-loved uniform is in exceptional condition and washed ready to be worn and 'loved' again.

BOYS AND GIRLS

JEWELLERY

Earrings may be worn but they must be studs or small sleepers.
Necklaces and bracelets **MUST NOT BE WORN FOR SAFETY REASONS**. If your child is found wearing them, they will be asked to remove them and hand them to a teacher.

Meal Arrangements

Your child can either bring a packed lunch or have a hot school meal supplied by Chartwells, an outside company.

Once your child is enrolled at Orchards Junior School, you will receive an email with activation details of how to log in and order your hot school meals via Chartwells using ParentPay. If you need any assistance with this, please contact Mrs Lobb at Orchards Junior School.



If you think your child is eligible for **benefits-related free school meals** in accordance with the criteria listed below, please apply online to West Sussex County Council by using this link <https://www.westsussex.gov.uk/education-children-and-families/schools-and-colleges/free-school-meals/> - which can also be found on our school website under the Parents Tab – School Meals.

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400. as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

This will also enable your child's school to claim valuable 'pupil premium' funding to enhance the children's education.
